8. The particular information determined to be confidential is the Petitioner's

Petition for Approval of Attorney's Fee Contract and the Attorney's Fee

Contract, and addendum thereto, between Petitioner and Gunn Law Group, P.A.

and Mincone Law Group, P.A. The Confidential information may be viewed by

Petitioner and by the representatives of Gunn Law Group, P.A. and Mincone

Law Group, P.A.

9. The Court finds that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered

by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in

subdivision (c) of Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420 and that no less

restrictive means measures are available to protect the interests set forth in

subdivision (c).
