**ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO
DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Respondent's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) and (d)(1) filed pursuant to Judicial Administration 2.420. Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

1. This case is a civil injunction for protection against domestic violence.
2. The Court finds that the following grounds under Rule 2.420(c) apply: avoid substantial injuries to innocent third parties and there are no less restrictive measures available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c)(9)(A).
3. The following records, or portions thereof, are determined to be confidential:

- 4. The names and dates of birth of the then minor children are deemed to be confidential and the proper pseudonym would be: J.D.F, II and J.T.F.
- 5. The progress docket or similar records are determined confidential.
- 6. The following persons are permitted to view the confidential information: counsel of record for each party, the Clerk of Court, and court staff.
- 7. The Court finds that the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered are no broader than necessary to protect the interests at issue, and there are no less restrictive measures available, and the Clerk of Court is directed to publish the order in accordance with subdivision (d)(4).
- 8. This order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.

It is therefore **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Respondent's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) and (d)(1) is **GRANTED** as set forth above. The Clerk is directed to treat the identified records as confidential in accordance with this order and Rule 2.420.
